3.1 Installation flow

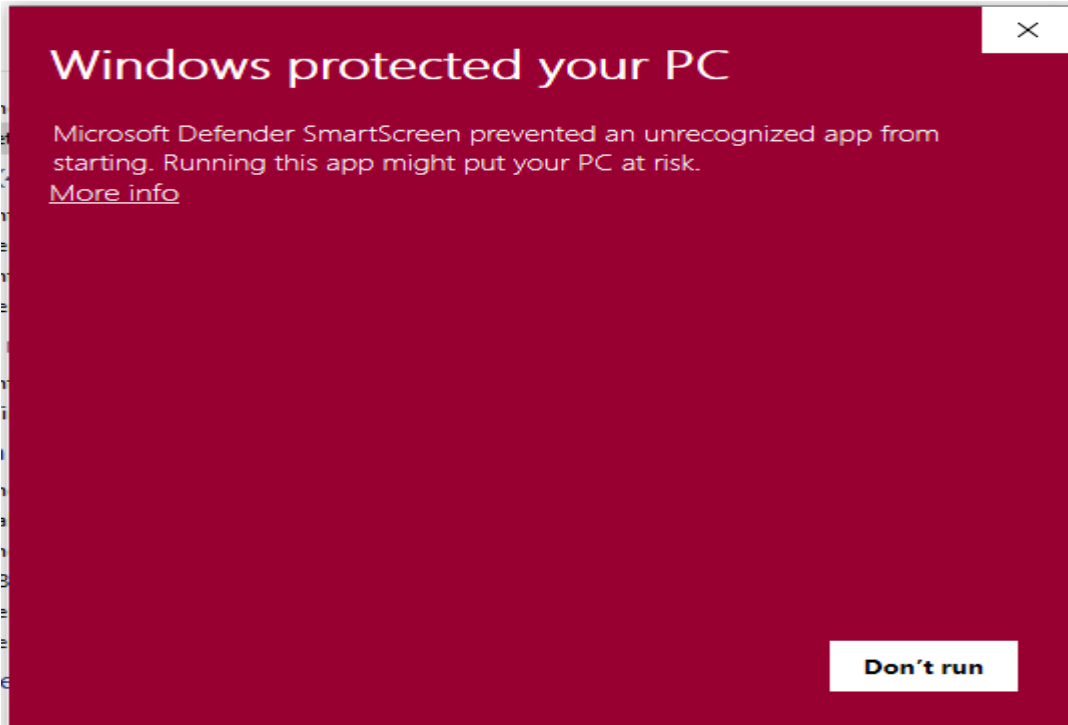
Use the procedures that follow to install or remove Unify Meeting software components together or individually.

Typical installation steps:

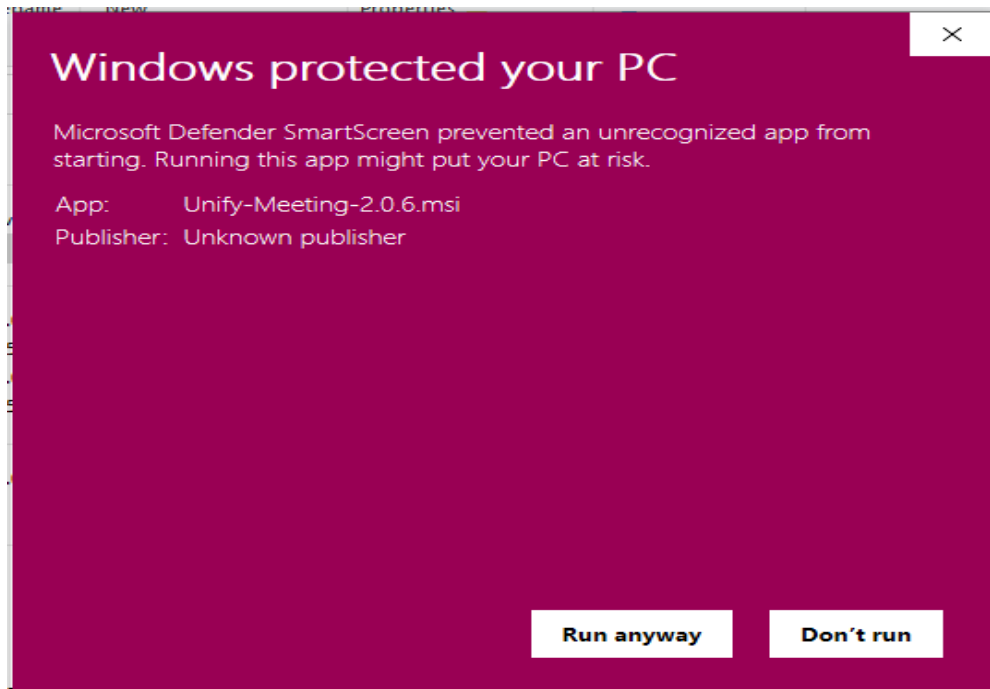
1. Double click on the downloaded .msi set up file.

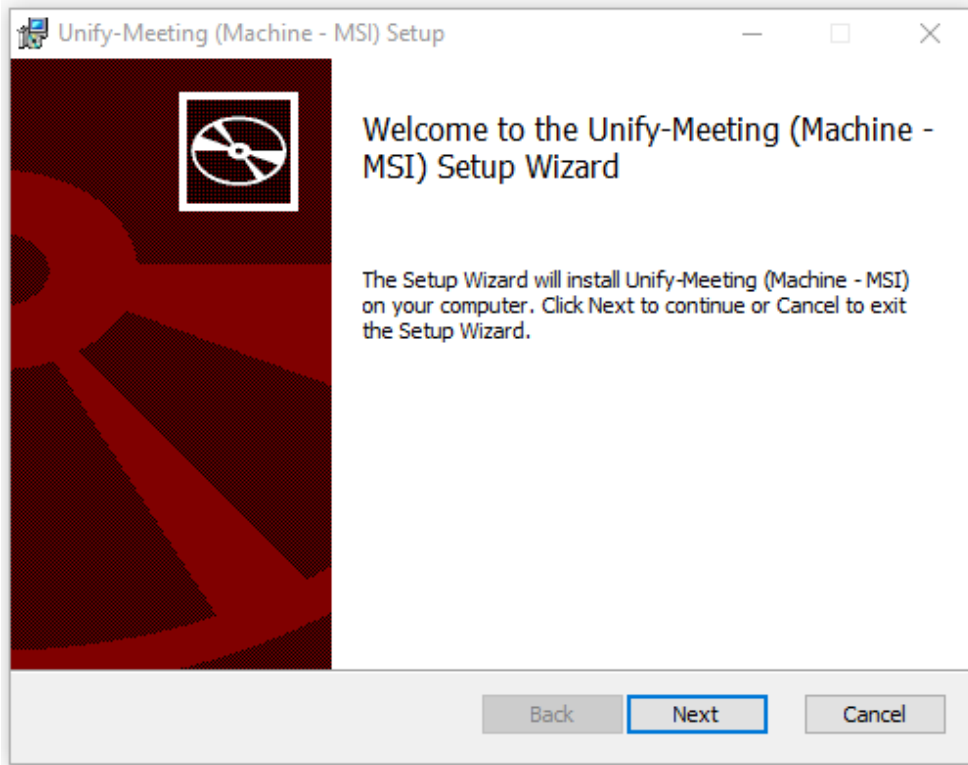
2. At the current stage of development the below warning popup has is being triggered, so click on the More info link from the popup.



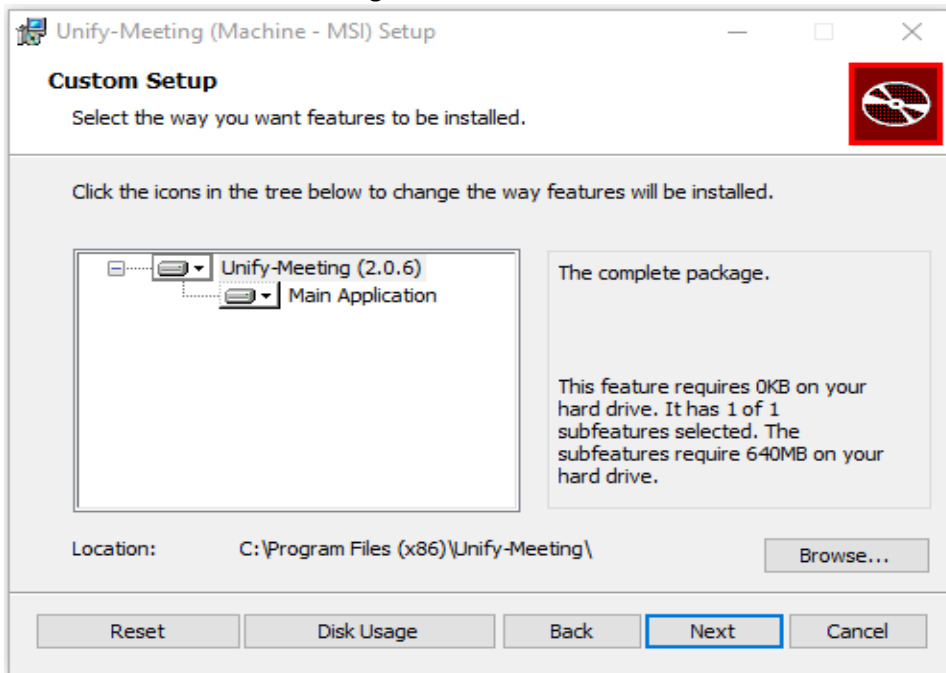
3. Click on the “Run Any Way” button.



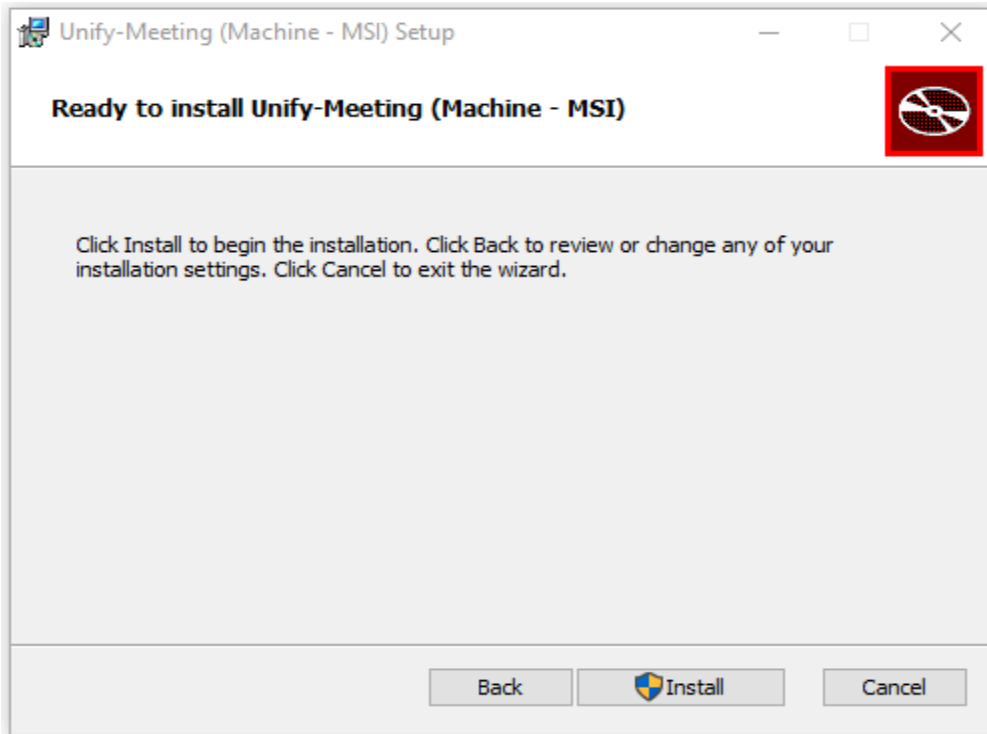
4. Click on the “Next” button.



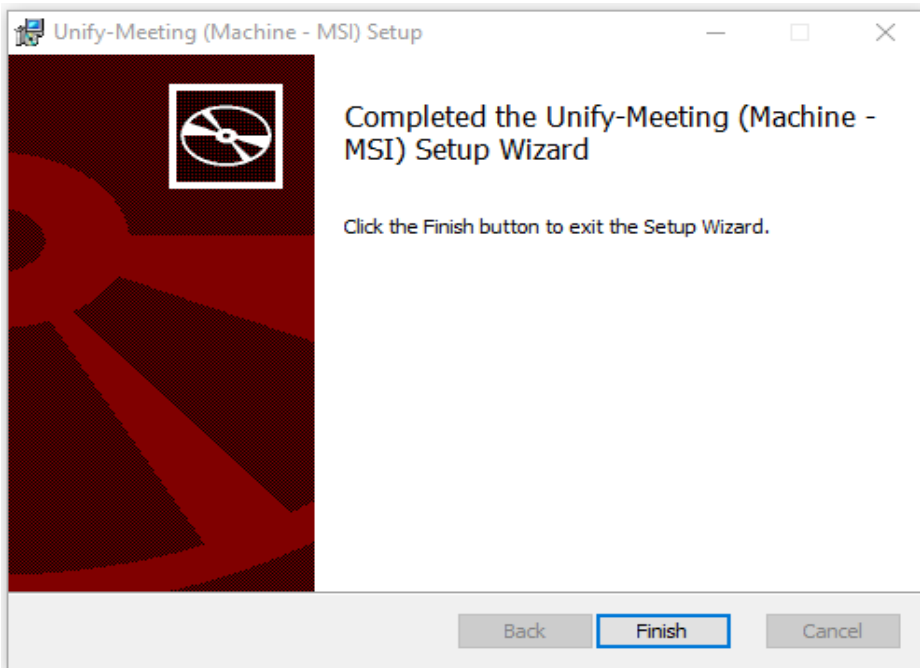
5. Click on the “Next” button again.

7. Click on the “Finish” button.



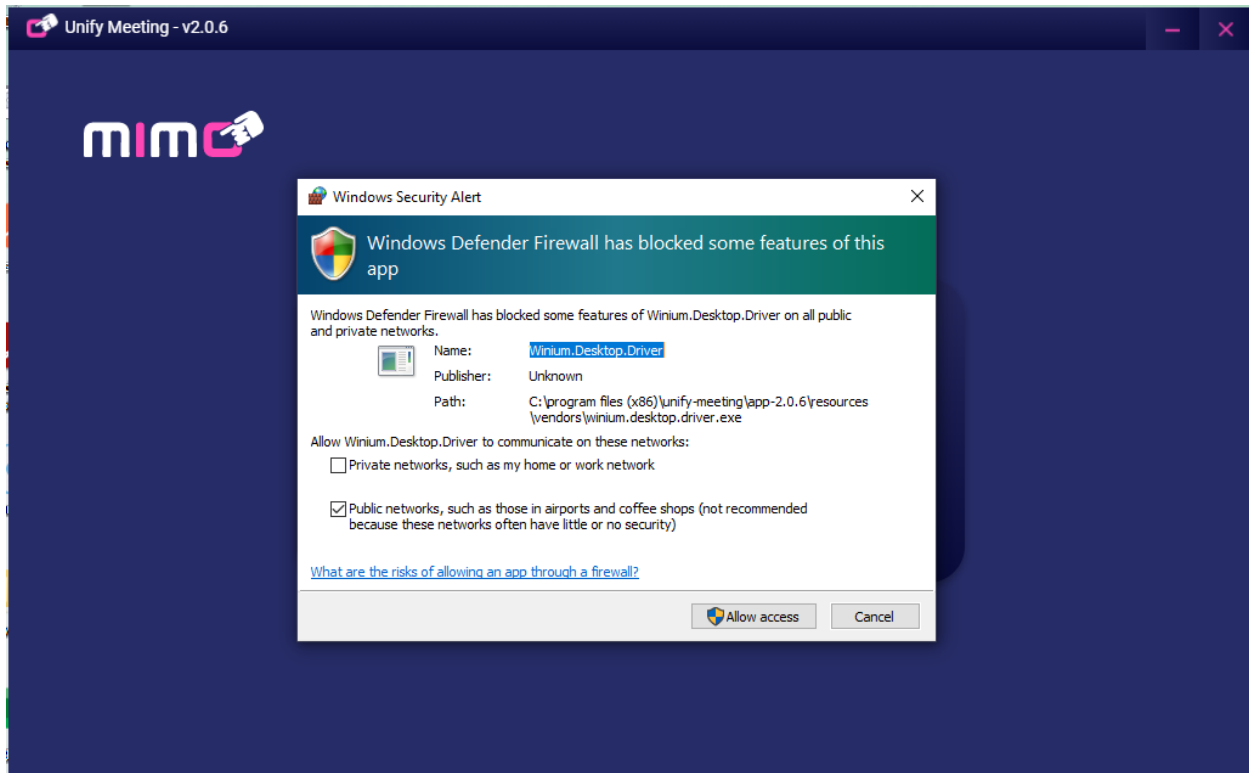
4. Typical installation

4.1 Installation procedure: typical installation

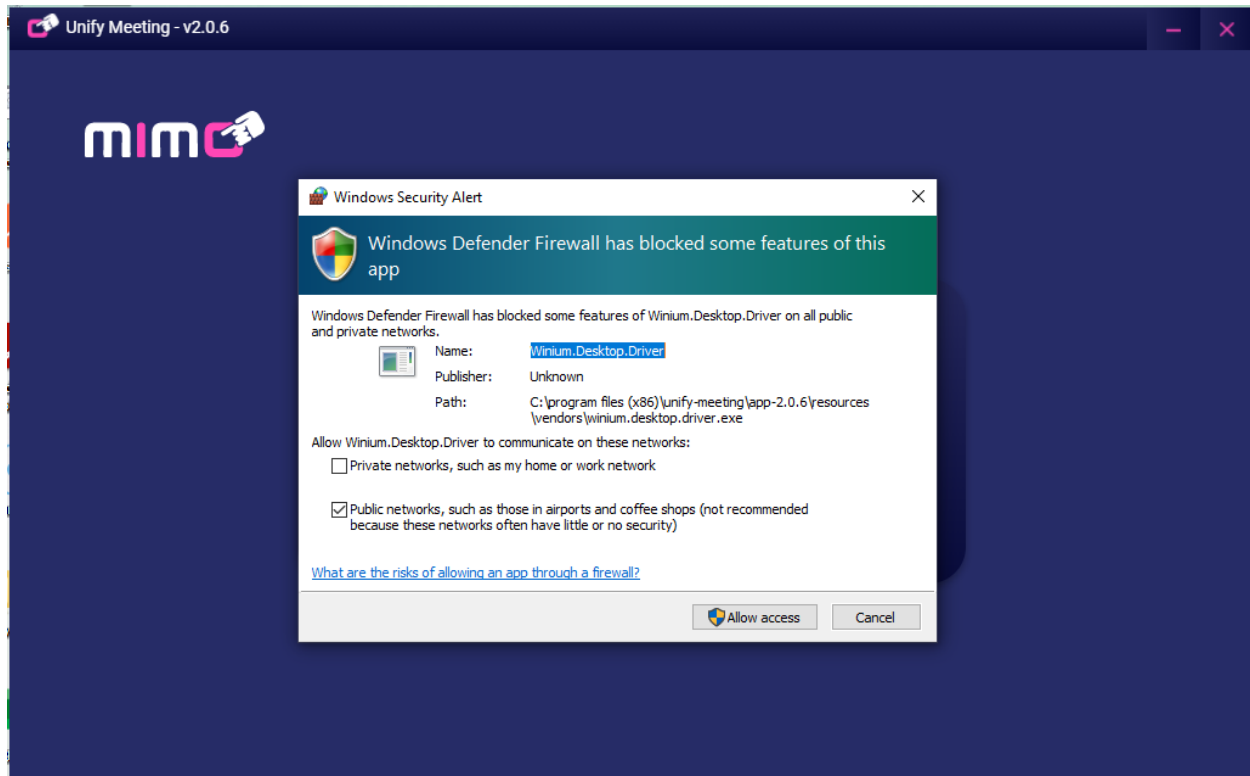
1. Make sure that you have followed the steps in Preparing to install.
2. Log on to the installation machine with appropriate permissions.
3. Download and start the installer, if needed.

After successful installation there will be a shortcut icon on Desktop with name “**Unify-Meeting**”. While opening first time it will open a popup and ask for permission. User should click on “Allow” in this popup.

4.2 To use the Unify Meeting software the user needs to install below apps in the system
